Field Trips

Bio-Technology

On 25th August, 2006 a field trip was conducted for III B.Sc. Bio-Technology students to Sangam Dairy, Vadlamudi accompanied by G.Sharmila Prasanthi and D.Veineela. Thirty students went to the Dairy. They interacted with the Staff of Dairy and observed various activities that were going at Sangam Dairy.

Thirty students interacted with the staff of water plant. They observed the plant and various activities that were going on in Water Purification Plant.

Marks obtained by the students were displayed on notice boards of the respective departments and the students who were below average were offered remedial coaching. To sum it up, CIE (Continuous Internal Evaluation) has been made more responsive to measure all the scholastic achievement of students.
