Part - A

The report details the various activities conceived and implemented in our college during the academic year 2007-08. The plan of action to ensure and enhance quality was chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year. The consequent follow-up action which was been realized is also shown:

Plan of Action for the year 2007-2008

- The institution wishes to take up more career guidance programmes and approach various companies holding of campus interviews.
- The institution proposes to offer seed money to all the departments to conduct extension lectures/ workshops/ surveys etc.
- To introduce B.Com with Computer Science after getting the approval from the concerned authorities.
- Proposals to conduct certificate courses and the seminars by different departments will be sent to the UGC, New Delhi.

Action Plan chalked out by the IQAC during 2007-2008

- Introduction of Autonomous mode at UG Level.
- To see Amounts be sanctioned by the Management to all the departments to conduct extension lectures, Workshops, Seminars and to purchase books for the Library.
- Introduction of B.Com Computer Course.
- To sensitise students to take up projects.

- To see the new language lab be established with a total of 50 computer systems exclusive for First and Second year Degree students.
- Departments of English, Commerce, History, Computer Science will conduct add on programme (Value Addition Programme) of 30-45 days duration.
- Feed-back will be obtained from students on the performance of teachers on functioning of various supporting services available in the institution. The feed-back obtained is scrutinized thoroughly and a detailed report will be submitted to the management for the follow up actions.
- Proposals to conduct national seminars by different departments will be sent to UGC, New Delhi.

Part - B

1 Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

- 1.1. Charging moderate fee this institution caters to the needs of students belonging to all vulnerable categories of the society. Students belonging to SC /ST /BC and listed minorities who are below the poverty line are provided with financial aid by way of scholarships.
- 1.2 Endowment scholarships instituted by various philanthropists and old students are being awarded every year as per the stipulated norms set by the respective trusts / individuals to the eligible students. (Refer Annexure-1)

Fourteen students participated in seminars conducted by various departments.

1.4. i) **Field Trips:**

- A Field Trip for III B.Sc. students was conducted on 26-09-'07. Twenty one students accompanied by Kum. Murali Ramya and Kum. N. Radha went to the Center for Cellular & Molecular Biology (CCMB), *Hyderabad*. Students and Staff interacted with the guide, Prof. Ajay Gaur and closely observed various activities of CCMB.

- A Field Trip for II B.Sc. students was conducted on 29-12-'07. Thirty three students accompanied by Smt.M.Anupama, *Head of the Department of Microbiology* and Ms B.V.Lavanya, *Lecturer in Microbiology* went to Municipal Water Treatment Plant, *Takkellapadu* . The students and staff interacted with the staff of the water treatment plant and observed various activities going on there like filtration, purification etc.,
- A Field Trip was conducted on 14-10-2007 for the Final year B.Sc. students. They were accompanied by Mr S.R.K. Prasad, Principal, T.V.Kiran Kumar, Ms Rohini Latha and Mr N.Srinivasa Rao. Forty Five students went to Vengalayapalem to acquaint themselves with the flora of the area.
- Mr S.R.K. Prasad, ex-Principal, Ms P.Shivani, Mr T.V.Kiran Kumar, Ms K.Rohini Latha and Mr N. Srinivasa Rao accompanied the students to collect plants available locally at JKC Nagar on 17.12.'07.

5 Examination Reforms Implemented

- Autonomous Status at UG level was conferred from the year 2006-2007. The First year degree programmes were under autonomous scheme during 2007-2008
- Semester System is in practice for degree students with 20 percent internal evaluation and 80 percent external evaluation.

- P.G. programmes have been continuing under Semester system.
- The second and the third year degree programmes, were under non-autonomous system and so, year-end pattern was followed. Examinations were conducted under the control and supervision of the Acharya Nagarjuna University to which our college is affiliated.
- Examination Reforms were implemented in the college by conducting class tests, monthly tests, quarterly, half-yearly, and model examinations. Marks obtained by the students were displayed on notice boards of the respective departments and the students who were below average were offered remedial coaching. To sum it up, CIE (Continuous Internal Evaluation) has been made more responsive to measure all the scholastic achievement of students.
